Rules of the Game:

- Cut out the cards and shuffle the cards. There are 36 cards – 18 pairs - in the deck.
- Pick a question card and find the matching answer within the answer cards and lay the cards out in pairs.
- Shuffle the cards again and turn the cards and put the cards out in form of a square 6x6 with the cards on their backside and play a memory game.
- Take one card, turn it over and read aloud, then uncover another card and read aloud. If the two cards show a question and an answer that match, the player keeps the matching cards aside. If there is no match, then turn over both cards again and the next player uncovers two cards in the pursuit of finding a matching pair. Try to remember where the previous cards were put back on the table and memorize their locations to uncover as many pairs as possible!
- It is the next player's turn when there is no matching pair uncovered.
- The winner of the game is the player with the highest number of matching pairs.

Mouna Kea on Hawaii is the tallest volcano but dormant. The summit is about 4207 m/ 13803 ft above sea level.

Mouna Loa on Hawaii is the largest active volcano. The summit is about 4169 m/ 13679 ft above sea level.
